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1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Annual Report to Parliament

Queensland's *Freedom of Information Act 1992* (the Act) is designed to give citizens a general right of access to Government's information in documentary form, in order to enhance democratic and representative processes. The guiding philosophy is that a public right of access to information makes Government more open, accountable and participatory. The Act also acknowledges that individual citizens justly require access to the information recorded by Government concerning their personal affairs and the means to ensure that such information is accurate and up-to-date. The qualifications to these principles, contained in the Act, are based upon the need to protect essential public and private interests which would suffer if there was an unrestricted public right to access all classes of information, including, for example, information about the private affairs of individuals. A number of the qualifications require an assessment of the competing public interest considerations as they arise on a case by case basis.

Section 108 of the Act requires the responsible Minister to prepare a report on the operation of the Act for each financial year, to be tabled in the Legislative Assembly.

This report for 2002–03 is the eleventh prepared under section 108 since the commencement of the Act. It represents a significant whole-of-government endeavour. All agencies subject to the Act (which includes the central departments of government, public authorities and local governments) have, throughout the year, collected and recorded detailed information about the applications received, the decisions taken, the documents to which access was given or refused, the grounds of refusal, and the outcomes of the review processes, for inclusion in this report.

1.2 Amendments to Freedom of Information Legislation in 2001

The substantive provisions of the *Freedom of Information Amendment Act 2001* (No. 70) commenced on 23 November 2001, along with significant amendments to the *Freedom of Information Regulation 1992*.

The amendments had three broad objectives:

- 1. to address the problems associated with applications so wide in scope that dealing with them involves a substantial and unreasonable diversion of public resources away from the performance of other aspects of public service, including emergency and essential services;
- 2. the recovery of charges in respect of the work undertaken in dealing with applications other than applications made by individuals for access to documents concerning their personal affairs; and
- 3. waiver of such charges on grounds of financial hardship for both individuals and community groups.

An important element in the amendments is the recognition of the importance of agency-applicant consultation. Thus, agencies are required to signal in advance an intention to refuse to deal with an application on the grounds of substantial and unreasonable diversion of resources, and to assign an officer to attempt to negotiate refinements to the application to remove that ground of refusal. Similarly, agencies are required to estimate and give notice of the anticipated charges to applicants who will be subject to the charging regime, once again with a view to reaching an agreed refinement of the scope of an application, which will reduce the charges to be incurred. Avenues for review of agency decisions on these matters remain.

2.0 SUBSECTION 108(4)—OPERATIONS OF AGENCIES AND MINISTERS

2.1.1 Overview of statistics

During the 2002–03 reporting period, 11,111 applications (5,566 personal and 5,545 non-personal) were received in relation seeking access to documents. State Government agencies received 9,872 applications (5,362

personal and 4,510 non-personal) with local governments accounting for 1,239 applications (204 personal and 1,035 non-personal).

The dichotomy between the 'personal' and 'non-personal' application, as employed throughout this report, is somewhat technical and requires a brief explanation. It does not simply involve a distinction between applications made by private citizens for personal reasons as distinct from all other types of application, for example, those made by media organisations or commercial concerns. An applicant who seeks to access a document that does not concern his or her personal affairs is required to pay an application fee and the application can be described as 'non-personal'. A document concerns the applicant's personal affairs if it contains at least some information about the applicant in relation to his or her personal affairs, although this need not be the dominant theme of the document. The individual's personal affairs in this context involve the private and domestic aspects of life, that is, one's affairs in a private capacity. If any one or more of the documents sought cannot be characterised in this way, the application is deemed to be 'non-personal'. The key point of distinction is that the 'nonpersonal' application is subject to an application fee (presently set by regulation at \$33.50 payable on making the application) whereas 'personal' applications are not subject to any fee.

The total number of applications represents an increase of 1% (114 applications) from the previous year.





Figure 1 below provides a comparison of the number of applications received during the operation of the Act.

Figure 2 indicates that the Police portfolio received the largest number of FOI applications for 2002–03, a total of 2,145 applications were received, 208 more then last year, equating to a 10.7% increase. Substantial proportional increases in numbers of applications received were experienced in the following portfolios: Public Works and Housing (41.6%), Treasury (31.3%), Industrial Relations (27.2%) and Education (21.2%).



The 'other' category in Figure 2 includes all the remaining State Government portfolios not specifically mentioned in the chart.



2.2.1 Action taken on documents considered

Documents sought under the Act may be made accessible in full or in part (that is, subject to the deletion of some exempt matter) or access may be refused if the documents are found to be exempt. Figure 3 indicates the actions taken with

2.5 Paragraph 108(4)(e)—Applications for review by Information Commissioner

At the beginning of the 2002–03 financial year the Information Commissioner brought forward 124 un-finalised applications for external review of agency and Ministerial decisions from the previous reporting period.

A further 212 fresh applications for external review were received by the Information Commissioner in 2002–03. The Information Commissioner finalised 275 applications during the reporting period and 61 applications were carried forward into the 2003–04 reporting period for further consideration.

The Information Commissioner publishes important decisions containing broadly applicable statements of principle for the administration of the Act as a formal decision series. The formal series, in full text, is made available on the Information Commissioner's website at <u>www.slq.qld.gov.au/infocomm</u> and free on the Australian Legal Information Institute (AustLII) website at <u>www.austlii.edu.au/</u>.

They are also published by LBC Information Services in the *Queensland Administrative Reports*. The Information Commissioner's website also has summaries of unreported, informal decisions, information sheets and practitioners' guidelines.

2.6 Paragraph 108(4)(f)—Statement of Affairs and notices received

The Act requires that each agency publish, at least yearly, an up-to-date statement of affairs describing its structure and functions, how its functions affect members of the community, its arrangements for public participation in policy formulation and the exercise of it functions, the kinds of documents held and how they can be accessed and other aspects of the agency's business. Under section 20(1) of the Act, any member of the public can serve a notice on any agency contending that an agency is not complying with its obligation to publish a proper statement of affairs. No notices were served in 2002–03.

2.7 Paragraph 108(4)(g)—Disciplinary action

There were no reported instances of disciplinary action arising from the administration of the Act.

2.8 Paragraph 108(4)(h)—Fees and Charges collected by agencies

Information about the amounts of charges collected by agencies in the reporting period is contained in:

As observed earlier in this report; amendments to the Act, which came into force in November 2001, introduced charges for time spent by agency staff in dealing with non-personal applications, in addition to charges for production or reproduction of documents.

By way of example, the following agencies collected total charges in 2002–03 compared to the previous period, as follows:

Education Queensland increased from \$546.60 to \$4,905.15;

Treasury increased from \$2,118.20 to \$7,104.60;

Department of Employment Training and Arts decreased from \$2,615.60 to \$1,155.40;

Department of the Premier and Cabinet decreased from \$1,383.90 to \$769.40;

In each instance, there is a very significant proportional variation, but the total charges collected remain low and represent a small part of the costs incurred by the agency in administering the Act.

On the other hand, the variations in the amount collected in fees and charges by the agencies listed below seem more significant as total amounts:

Industrial Relations increased from \$56,682.60 to \$68,744.72;

Department of Transport and Main Roads increased from \$22,600.15 to \$28,901.78

Whilst providing for more realistic (though only partial) cost recovery by agencies, the new charging arrangements also require early notification of estimated charges, giving applicants the opportunity to revise the scope of applications in order to minimise expense. An agency may be very successful in refining applications by negotiation, and make significant cost savings in doing so, without recovering more revenue in charges. It is also important to bear in mind that no charge is made for non-personal applications that consume less than 2 hours in staff time in chargeable activity. Some agencies, by reason of the general trends in applications received, will collect less in charges simply because a greater proportion of nonpersonal applications received can be dealt with in less than 2 hours of staff time, especially if the scope of particular applications can be refined by negotiation with applicants. By way of example, within the Department of Justice and Attorney-General a large number of applications concern closed coroners' files. For this class of application a discrete file of attached papers can readily be identified and retrieved in connection with a given application. The Department's decision-maker is able to formulate and apply a general policy of disclosure of certain types of information to parties demonstrating a sufficient interest. Some cases will justify departures from the general policy, but there is a degree of standardization to the decision-making that produces efficiencies and many applications require no more than 2 hours consumption of officer-time.

2.9 Paragraph 108(4)(i)—Reading room and other access facilities

A number of agencies have established dedicated reading rooms in which internally and externally published literature is retailed, and policy documents and some library holdings are made available to interested members of the community. All agencies report that conference and other rooms are generally available for inspections of documents accessed under the Act or under other arrangements.

2.10 Paragraph 108(4)(j)—Other efforts to implement and administer the FOI Act

2.10.1 Training

Most agencies report efforts to maintain and increase awareness and understanding of the essentials of FOI by agency personnel. Agencies generally have recognised the importance of introducing FOI to employees new to the public sector, and include some information about FOI in induction processes. Broad awareness within agencies is important, both in inculcating a philosophy of openness and ensuring that all officers are able to assist members of the public in making FOI applications or using other arrangements to access information. Awareness discussions and formal training sessions have been undertaken by a large proportion of agencies during 2002–03. Queensland Health, for example, has a training program for decision-makers and reserve decision-makers for the health service districts and health agencies tailored to the specific issues that arise within that sector.

2.10.2 FOI awareness

Most agencies provide information and relevant links on their web pages for people interested in accessing agency information, either by way of the Act or through other arrangements. Increasingly, agencies put electronic versions of literature, policies and discussion papers on their web pages, which is consistent with the stated objectives of the Act to promote open discussion of public affairs and to keep the community aware of Government's operations.

2.10.3 Administrative access

Generally, agencies and departments promoted and developed administrative release arrangements, with some agencies establishing 'Administrative Release' units working in tandem with the FOI decision makers. These units facilitate access to documents outside the FOI process. This improved client service ensures timely access to documents.

A good example is provided by the Department of Families, which has established a dedicated team to provide former residents of State Government run or licensed institutions with access to personal records, following the recommendations of the Forde Commission of Inquiry into Abuse of Children in Queensland Institutions.

2.10.4 Electronic processing

The Department of Primary Industries (DPI) uses its email network to process FOI applications. Applications may be received and acknowledged by email. DPI is also developing electronic means of payment of FOI fees and charges.

Other agencies are also moving towards a paperless FOI process. This is a costeffective process in which physical files and relevant correspondence are stored electronically thereby reducing the reliance on paper copies of documents. A number of agencies are currently using, while others have been investigating, 'redaction' technology developed some years ago by the United States Department of Defense for use in editing and storing documents relevant to FOI applications and litigation.

2.10.5 FOIonLine


The Department of Justice and Attorney-General has continued its development of new database software called *FOIonLine*. Considerable work was undertaken in the reporting period on record locking and validation testing of the system. *FOIonLine* is now used by the Department of Justice and Attorney-General, Department of Primary Industries, Department of Natural Resources and Mines and Environmental Protection Agency, and a number of local governments, either through the Queensland Government's Intranet *GovNet* or in a stand alone mode.

3.0 AMENDMENT APPLICATIONS

3.1 Number of amendment applications

26 applications for amendment of documents were received in 2002–03, amongst 8 agencies, representing an increase of 52.9% on the 2001–02 figures of 17.

Figure 4 below shows the yearly trend comparisons since 1992–93.



APPENDICES

- (iii) if the decision in respect of which the application was made was a decision that an applicant is not entitled to access to a document in accordance with an application—the provision of this Act under which the matter was classified as exempt matter; and

(f) the number of notices served upon the principal officer of the agency under section 20(1) and the number of decisions by the principal officer which were adverse to the person's claim; and

(g) particulars of any disciplinary action taken against an officer in relation to the administration of this Act; and

(h) the amount of fees and charges collected by the agency or Minister; and
