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1.0 INTRODUCTION

Annual Report to Parliament

This report has been prepared pursuant to section 108 (Report to Legislative Assembly by Agencies and Ministers) of the *Freedom of Information Act 1992* (the Act). Under this section, agencies are required to collate statistical data for the preparation of the report. The section also requires the Minister administering the Act, the Honourable Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister for the Arts, to prepare the report and table it in the Legislative Assembly.

2.0 SUBSECTION 108(4) STATISTICAL DATA / ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIVITIES

2.1 Introduction

On 11 March 1999, the Queensland Parliament referred the *Freedom of Information Act 1992* to the Legal, Constitutional and Administrative Review Committee (LCARC) for review. The terms of reference require LCARC to, among other things, examine whether the fundamental purposes and principles of the Act have been satisfied and whether or not the exemptions need to be amended.

As agencies wishing to advocate any amendments to the Act, including changes to fees and charges, have the opportunity of making submissions to LCARC, this report primarily addresses the issues in subsection 108(4) of the Act.

The Committee's Terms of Reference are included in the Appendices.

2.2 Subsection 108(4)(a) – Number of applications



2.2.1 Overview of Statistics

For the current reporting period, a total of 6 829 applications were received by State Government agencies in relation to requests for access to documents, with Local Government agencies receiving 973. The total number of applications received this year is slightly higher than last year due to the large number of applications received by Local Government.


Graph 2.1 below provides a comparison of the number of applications received during the operation of the Act.

Graph 2.2 shows that the Queensland Police Service continues to receive the largest number of FOI applications. It also indicates that the group of agencies that receive the most applications has remained relatively constant since the commencement of the Act. The "Other" category, which accounts for 52% of applications, refers to the remaining government agencies.



2.3.1 Action on documents considered

Documents sought under Freedom of Information can be released in full, partly released or withheld from release. Graph 2.3 below shows the actions taken (that is, full and partial release or access refused) on documents considered by State Government agencies during the operation of the Act.



During the 1998-99 reporting period, 726 976 documents were considered by State Government agencies with access refused to 73 552 documents, or approximately 10%. Full access was given to 606 547 documents (83%) and 46 874 given partial release (7%). See graph 2.4 below.


Actions on Documents taken by State Government Agencies during the 1998-1999 Financial Year.



There was also a sharp increase in the number of documents Local Government authorities considered during the 1998-99 financial year – in total, 415 365 documents were considered, in comparison to 145 183 documents in the previous reporting period. This increase correlates to the high number of applications received. Graph 2.5 depicts the actions taken.

2.6 Subsection 108(4)(e) – Applications for review by Information Commissioner

At the beginning of the 1998/99 financial year, 217 applications were lodged with the Information Commissioner for external review. The Information Commissioner received a further 291 applications, during the financial year in question. The Commissioner completed 301 applications during the reporting period, the remaining 207 applications were carried forward into the new 1999/00 financial year.

The applications received during the 1998/99 financial year were divided into the following categories:

Access is available to the decisions of the Information Commissioner through the Information Commissioner's web site at www.slg.qld.gov.au/infocomm. As these decisions are readily available to the public and other interested agencies they are not reproduced in this report. The Commissioner's Annual Report 1998/99 also contains a summary of all decisions made within the 1998/99 financial year. The report can be accessed at the above web site.

2.7 Subsection 108(4)f – Statement of Affairs and notices received

The Act requires each agency to publish annually a ‘Statement of Affairs’ outlining its structure and functions and related information. Provision is made under subsection 20(1) of the Act for members of the public to serve a notice on any agency, as specified in the Act, if their Statement of Affairs does not comply with the requirements or if the Statement was not published at all. During the reporting period in question, no agencies received notices in accordance with section 20(1).

2.8 Subsection 108(4)(g) – Disciplinary action

For the 1998-99 reporting period, no agencies reported any disciplinary action in relation to the administration of the Act.

2.10 Subsection 108(4)(i) – Reading room and other access facilities

The majority of the agencies associated with the processing of access applications under the Act have a designated reading room available for the perusal of released documents.

In addition to offering the perusal of released documents, a number of agencies have made other documents available to the general public within their reading rooms. These documents include documents relating to the administration of the Act, publications such as Statements of Affairs, Annual Reports and application forms.

The Queensland Police Service has reported that, due to the decentralised nature of the organisation, access to policy documents and other material is generally available through each police station. Where these documents are not available locally, procedures exist that allow for copies to be either sent directly to the applicant or sent to a police station where the applicant can peruse the requested documents.

2.11 Subsection 108(4)(j) – Other efforts to implement and administer the Act

2.11.1 Training

The majority of agencies associated with the administration of the Act have commenced various forms of internal training to educate staff in freedom of information policy and procedures.

2.11.2 FOI Information

The Department of Corrective Services has implemented several strategies to enhance the administration of the Act. The Department produces a form listing the various types of documents kept on prison files, to better inform prisoners about the types of documents that may be accessed under FOI. The Prisoners' Handbook describes the procedures for making an FOI application. Further, the Department's FOI unit makes regular contributions to the Departmental newsletter "Corrections News" on FOI related matters.

A number of agencies, including the Department of Tourism, Sport and Racing, the Department of Mines and Energy and the Department of Primary Industries, have made FOI information available to the public via their Internet web sites. The Department of Primary Industries has also developed procedures for the receipt and processing of applications electronically through its electronic mail network which has resulted in a reduction of costs and more efficient use of resources.

2.11.3 FOI Productivity Increases

Queensland Police Service (QPS) reported that in 1997-98, the agency received the largest volume of FOI applications and that this trend was likely to continue. To address the trend and to continue the commitment of the QPS to open and accountable government, further resources were allocated to the QPS FOI Unit. This has resulted in the following productivity increases:

- turnaround time for acknowledgment letters reduced from approximately 7 days to 2 days
- reduction of unfinalised overdue applications from approximately 200 to 30 at any given time.

2.11.4 Administrative Access

Since March 1994, Queensland Health has endorsed the "Administrative Access to Health Records Policy" as the preferred mechanism for access to health records. This policy enables individuals to view their own health records (and be provided with photocopies) under the supervision of a treating health professional or other appropriate health professionals. Information contained within the record can be explained or clarified by the health professional at the time of the inspection. The implementation of this policy has resulted in the granting of administrative access to a

significant number of health records. For example, the Princess Alexandra Hospital processed 947 administrative access applications in 1998/99.

The Department of Primary Industries has developed an administrative access process for specific information to be made routinely available to all parties involved within a certain career progression scheme. Prior to the introduction of this process, staff, who had applied under the scheme and were unsuccessful, were regularly making FOI applications to access documents relating to the career progression scheme. Since the introduction of "administrative access" there have been significantly fewer FOI applications made by staff adversely affected by decisions made under the career progression scheme.

Similarly, the administrative access schemes of WorkCover Queensland and the Division of Work Place Health and Safety, Department of Employment, Training and Industrial Relations have proved to be a popular, alternative source of access for interested parties.


3.0 ADDITIONAL DATA

3.1 Number of amendment applications

There has been a steady decline in the number of applications for amendment of information received by all agencies over the past few years

A peak of 50 such applications was reached during the 1993-1994 reporting period, with 47 received by State Government agencies and 3 received by Local Government authorities. However, only 13 applications were received this year by State Government, and 2 by Local Government. Graph 3.1 depicts this decline.


Graph 3.1
Comparison of Amendment Applications Received During the Act's Operation




3.2 Response times

Response times for processing applications have remained largely consistent over the Act's duration. The majority of applications, at both State and Local Government level, are processed within 45 days. However, a significant number of applications take over 70 days to process, see graphs 3.2 and 3.3 below. It is suggested that this is due to a high volume of applications requesting a voluminous number of documents.

Appendix 1 Statistical Data

The information in the following tables was supplied by agencies. Care has been taken to confirm data and to double check anomalies, however the collection of accurate data remains the responsibility of each agency.

Within the Appendices 1.9 and 1.10, which refer to internal review decisions, one document equates to one page. No provision is listed as having been invoked more than once for one document but different provisions may, however, be invoked in regard to the one document. Therefore, the number of times any one provision is invoked may not be more than the total number of documents released in part or refused, but the total number of provisions invoked may be more than this total.

Within the Appendices 1.5 and 1.6, which refer to the types of applications received, the total number of applications received does not include applications brought forward from the previous year or applications withdrawn, transferred or lapsed.

Legal, Constitutional & Administrative Review Committee Terms of Reference FOI Act 1992 Review

That having regard to:

- (a) the basic purposes of, and benefits intended to be conferred by the provisions of the *Freedom of Information Act 1992*, (the FOI Act) as identified in:
 - (i) the Electoral and Administrative Review Committee report on freedom of information;
 - (ii) the report of the Parliamentary Committee for Electoral and Administrative Review on Freedom of Information for Queensland; and
 - (iii) sections 4, 5 and 6 of Part 1 Divisions 2 of the FOI Act;
- (a) the principles and provisions of the various Commonwealth, State and Territory Freedom of Information Acts;
- (b) the philosophical and political foundations of the concept of freedom of information as identified in the report of the Senate Standing Committee on Constitutional and Legal Affairs on Freedom of Information (1979); and
- (c) current and emerging technology for information management and maintenance.

The following matters be referred to the Legal, Constitutional & Administrative Review Committee for inquiry and report:

- A. Whether the basic purposes and principles of the freedom of information legislation in Queensland as set out above have been satisfied, and whether they now require modification.
- B. Whether the *FOI Act* should be amended, and in particular:
 - (i) whether the objects clauses should be amended;
 - (ii) whether, and to what extent, the exemption provisions in Part 3 Division 2 should be amended;
 - (iii) whether the ambit of the application of the Act, both generally and by operation of section 11 and section 11A, should be narrowed or extended;
 - (iv) whether the *FOI Act* allows appropriate access to information in electronic and non-paper formats;
 - (v) whether the mechanisms set out in the Act for internal and external review are effective, and in particular, whether the method of review and decision by the Information Commissioner is excessively legalistic and time-consuming;
 - (vi) the appropriateness of, and the need for, the existing regime of fees and charges in respect of both access to documents and internal and external review;
 - (vii) whether amendments should be made to minimise the resource implications for agencies subject to the *FOI Act* in order to protect the public interests in proper and efficient government administration, and in particular:
 - whether section 28 provides an appropriate balance between the interests of applicants and agencies;
 - whether data collection and reporting requirements, which inform the parliamentary and public understanding of how well the *FOI Act* is operating in Queensland, exceed what is necessary to achieve their legislative purpose;
 - whether time limits are appropriate.
 - (viii) whether amendments should be made to either section 42(1) or section 44(1) of the Act to exempt from disclosure information concerning the identity or other personal details of a person (other than the applicant) unless its disclosure would be in the public interest having regard to the use(s) likely to be made of the information;
 - (ix) whether amendments should be made to the Act to allow disclosure of material on conditions in the public interest (for example, to a legal representative who is prohibited from disclosing it to the applicant);
- C. Any related matter.
